ADDRESSING THE SALIENT LEGAL ISSUES WITHIN THE BRICS DISCOURSE REQUIRES A COMPREHENSIVE, COMPARATIVE APPROACH THAT EXPLORES THE DIFFERENT SOLUTIONS PROVIDED BY EACH MEMBER COUNTRY, IN ORDER TO IDENTIFY SIMILARITIES AND CONVERGENCES. IN HIS 45TH BOOK, MARTIN HAS INTERVIEWED 30 MAJOR CHARACTERS - INCLUDING COVERDALE - TO PIECE TOGETHER THE BAND'S CONVOLUTED HISTORY.
